



How to Install SCS Mosaic

Installation of Software

Before installing Mosaic, please de-install any previous versions of Mosaic from your computer. Go to “Start”; select “Control Panel” and click on “Add or Delete Programs”. Delete Mosaic. This will not eliminate any personal Mosaic data from the system.

Mosaic is distributed either on a CD-ROM or as part of the Mosaic Activity Center (notebook computer and panel). The Activity Center does not require software installation because it is already available on the hard drive. *If you have the **Activity Center**, please skip to the **Panel Set-Up** section below.* To install Mosaic with the CD-ROM, follow the steps below:

1. Place disk in CD-ROM drive; the installation procedure should run automatically.
2. If it does not run automatically, look for the "setup.exe" file on the CD-ROM and follow the installation instructions from the setup dialogs.

Panel Set-Up

The panel that accompanies the software and/or notebook will have 4, 8 or 24 buttons. To connect the panel to the notebook or your own computer, follow these steps:

1. Each panel has a cable which connects to the computer’s USB port.
2. Connect the provided USB cable between the panel and computer.
3. Once these pieces are in place, turn your computer on. A dialog box will appear on your screen indicating that the computer has found a new device. Click “Okay” or close the box.
4. Mosaic is now ready for use with the panel. Mosaic will operate with a panel, a mouse or a touchscreen. However, the panel must be plugged in when using any of these options.
